Andrew Shapiro is Global Head of Loan Syndication and UK Head of Structured Finance and VPG. Loan Syndication is comprised of 160 people in 16 countries. UK Structured Finance activities include Leveraged Finance, Project Finance, Media & Telecom Finance, Export Finance and Corporate Acquisition Finance.

Prior to these activities, Andrew was Head of the Value Preservation Group and Corporate Acquisition Finance for the Americas. Value Preservation Group was comprised of 22 professionals responsible for managing restructuring activities with respect to the bank's portfolio of loan and capital markets exposures throughout the Americas. Corporate Acquisition Finance was a team of 17 professionals responsible for co-originating, structuring and executing loan lead mandates for the bank's corporate clients throughout the Americas.

Andrew has also co-headed BNP Paribas' Loan & High Yield Capital Market Group, where he was responsible for loan and High Yield Bond origination, structuring and execution for Corporate and Sponsor clients throughout the Americas. Before co-heading this group, Andrew held senior positions at BNP Paribas in the Syndication, Trading & Placement Group and Risk. Andrew joined BNP Paribas in 1996. Prior to this, he held positions in Leveraged Finance, asset recovery and distressed debt trading at Swiss Bank (now UBS).
